The Antis Township Supervisors will receive sealed bids until 9:30am prevailing local time on the 23rd day of March 2023 at the Antis Township Municipal Building, 909 N. Second Street, Bellwood, PA 16617. At that time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the following contract:

Contract 2023-1: 5th Street Park Improvements Project

The project includes improvements to the 5th Street park consisting of asphalt parking, concrete sidewalks, fencing, landscaping and open field restoration.

Contract Documents may be obtained at the Hollidaysburg office of Stiffler, McGraw & Associates, Inc. Payment for the Contract Documents will be \$53.00, which price includes 6% Pennsylvania Sales Tax. Digital Copies are available in PDF format at a 50% discount of the paper copies cost. All checks should be made payable to Stiffler, McGraw & Associates, Inc. Fee is non-refundable. A \$10.00 fee for postage and handling will be required for Contract Documents that are mailed to bidders. Faxed bids will not be accepted.

A certified check or bank draft, made payable to Antis Township Supervisors or a satisfactory Bid Bond on the form provided, executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total of the Bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay for satisfactory Performance and Payments Bonds, on the forms provided each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price.

Funding for this project is provided in part by a grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Bureau of Recreation and Conservation's Environmental Stewardship Fund.

Bidders for this contract shall have completed projects similar in character and scope and will be required to provide with their Bid a Qualifications Statement for prime contractor and all subcontractors.

All contractors and subcontractors shall comply with the Public Works Employment Verifications Act. The Act requires the contractor to verify employment eligibility through the e-verify program operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security as a precondition of being awarded a contract for this project. The contract documents contain information and verification Form regarding the Act.

Pennsylvania prevailing wage rates will apply to this contract. The contract documents contain requirements addressing prevailing labor wage rates, labor standards, nondiscrimination in hiring practices and related matters.

Addenda, if any, will be issued to only those persons whose names and address are on record with Stiffler, McGraw & Associates, Inc. as having obtained the Contract Documents.

The Antis Township Supervisors reserve the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.
